**TOPICS**: we will accept original works about Acupuncture and the other MTCV disciplines applied to any animal species. The abstracts will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee and the acceptance will be communicated via email only by **June 15 th, 2024**.

It is necessary to include the email of the first author only for all communications.

Every first author of the four approved abstracts for the discussion will receive a  $50 \in$  discount on the subscription fee.

The works must be written in English, in a Tahoma 12 font – single spaced – justified text – and follow the model below:

**CHAPTER BREAKDOWN** Original research: scope of the work, materials, methos used, results obtained and conclusions. Clicinal cases: Introduction, DEscription of the case and Discussion.

Maximum total 5400 characters spaces included (mandatory) • Charts, tables and images will not be published • The ESSENTIAL Bibliography is mandatory and cannot be longer than 5400 characters • Abstracts without bibliographical references will not be admitted.

**ETHICAL NORMS** All works must be based on ethical principles, approved by the ethical committee of the institution of reference and accepted by the Congress Scientific Committee. All works must follow the guidelines for Good Practice, available at (<u>https://www.ema.europa.eu/docs/en\_GB/document\_library/Scien-</u>

tific\_guideline/2009/10/WC500004343.pdf). Thus, experimental procedures should be avoided at all time as well as the useless suffering on live animals. Works that do not respect these principles will be automatically rejected. If any personal animals are used, it is necessary to document the informed consent of the owner.

The approved works will be discussed in the dedicated session of the Seminar through a power point presentation. The presentation will last 15 minutes + 5 for questions.
